Share the Spotlight with the Person Who Matters Most to You!


On Saturday afternoon, we start with our "Grad Processional Program" in which each graduate is presented on the stage of Hildebrand Chapel while a description of their future plans and notes of gratitude are read by our student emcees.

As a graduate, you are invited to select a person who is important to you to escort you from the stage to your seat. Please note the following details:

- Notes about each grad will be read while the grad walks across the stage.
- Grads will pause in the center of the stage for an official photo and will then pause again at the top of the stairs so that friends and family can take photos.
- Grads will then be escorted to the grad pews by someone who has played a significant role in their lives parents or guardians, grandparents, aunts or uncles, baby nieces or nephews, mentors, RDs, RAs, etc. You cannot have a fellow grad escort you.
- The grads will sit together in the pews; the escorts will return to where they were sitting when the program began.
- The program will indicate which side each grad will be on so that escorts can meet them at the correct side of the stage.
- On the online form linked on the "Forms for Graduates" page, you will be asked to include the name of your escort, their relationship with you and an email address that we can use to contact them to provide them with further information.



To enter the chapel:

- 1. Line up in the Hildebrand foyer on your correct side (Green, East West, Yellow) according to the order listed above.
- 2. Be sure your mortar board tassel is hanging over the *right* side.
- 3. Start entering when you hear Mrs. Ike inviting in "the graduating class of 2019."
- 4. Allow approximately 10 steps in between each grad; before entering the Hildebrand Chapel, glance over to the person entering on the opposite side and try to synchronize your progress all the way to the stage. Check at the bottom of the stage steps to synchronize your ascent of the stairs.
- 5. Enter the rows as detailed on page 1. Your names will be on your chairs. Remain standing until all students have entered; pause for a group photo with the staff and remain standing throughout "O, Canada."


On stage:

- 1. Be professional and do your best "adulting." 🐵
- 2. Sound from the stage carries and amplifies so avoid conversations.
- 3. No selfie sticks or obvious photography—"Good grief, Charlie Brown!"

To receive your diploma:

1. Row 1 stands and files out to stand on Stage East steps in the following order (sample):

- 2. When there are 3 people left to cross the stage from the previous row, the next row files out as above. Repeat.
- 3. When your name is called, walk forward to greet Mrs. Ike.
 - a. Shake her right hand with your right hand.
 - b. Receive your diploma with your left hand. 🙂
 - c. Pause with the diploma in front of you long enough for the photographer to give you a thumbs-up. \int



- d. Move forward to shake Dr. Pawelke's hand.
- 4. Return to your seat via the west stairway.
 - a. Team Yellow (west): File into your row from the west side.
 - b. Team Green (east): Walk up the west stairs, go behind the seated grads, then down the east stairs to enter your row from the east side.

To receive any awards:

- 1. Smile for your mommas or papas. 🙂
- 2. Remain at the front until the photographer gives you a thumbs-up. 😫
 - a. If you receive a team or group award, stay at the front until everybody has been recognized.

At the end of the ceremony:

- 1. You will be given the opportunity to move your mortar board tassels to the *left* in order to signify that you are a graduate!
- 2. You will be given an opportunity for a photo op tossing your hats; you will receive instructions. Keep track of where your hat goes so that you can pick it up as you exit the stage and take it with you/wear it for the recessional.
- 3. Exit in the same synchronized manner as you entered.
- 4. Enjoy the Alumni Tea and photos with your friends and families
- 5. Return your gowns promptly.
